Description

The DevOps Manager will play a critical role in designing, implementing, and maintaining our cloud infrastructure, with a focus on Microsoft Azure, Kubernetes, Micro Services, Microsoft 365 SaaS, and Citrix Cloud. Expertise in development release, scripting in Infrastructure as Code (IaC) and cloud automation will be crucial in ensuring efficient and reliable cloud operations. You will work closely with cross-functional teams to ensure the availability, reliability, and performance of our cloud-based systems. Responsibilities will include, but not be limited to:

- Developing and executing DevOps strategy aligned with company goals and industry best practices.
- Providing leadership, guidance, and mentorship to a team of DevOps engineers, fostering a culture of collaboration, accountability, and innovation
- Acting as a subject matter expert on DevOps best practices, providing guidance and support to stakeholders across the organization
- Leading the design, implementation, and maintenance of automated DevOps pipelines for build, test, deployment, and monitoring for digital and data applications
- Collaborating with development and operations teams to implement CI/CD pipelines and automate deployment processes
- Developing (IaC) and automating Azure services provisioning thru Azure DevOps pipeline

- Developing System images including but not limited to VDI, Server, VM, and Endpoint devices with drivers & firmware

- Providing Tier I/II/III support for application and cloud issues including but not limited to configuration, networking issues, performance, software bugs, deployment failures etc.
- Managing and optimizing Kubernetes clusters, ensuring high availability, scalability, and performance of containerized applications
- Using clear and concise language and format to write technical documentation and DR Runbook.
